- 6. **Ministry of Labour** (visited campus twice in March 2017) in response to a trip and fall on the sidewalk. During March 16 visit they inspected the new Wilson Building.

Orders were received that day.

- (1) Wilson Building (Belt drives on the door motors were not guarded) – hand could be caught in door - they were locked out immediately and they have now been guarded
- (2) Asked to develop a plan to identify and correct all Slips/Trips/Fall hazards on campus.
- That order has been rescinded by the Ministry because McMaster does have a program in place called Summer Works Program (funds are allotted to this program which involves repairing paths/sidewalk)

Because of the March 16th visit - An audit was conducted on campus (over 2 days) by our insurer to identify all trips/hazards – parking lots, sidewalks

Several were found and we now have inventory of hazards and prioritize to fix them through our Summer Works Program.

March 27, 2017 – Ministry responded to a slip and fall on ice – an employee fractured their ankle – no order issued because of that but it led to an inspection of BSB.

Mechanical Room - the eye wash shower was not working properly – not enough flow – order issued and it is fixed now.

4. Incident Reports

1. JHE-A106: Individual lowered hand press, handle was loose and slipped off, scratching hand. Supervisor arranged for han-

dle to be permanently attached to hand press.

- 2. ETB-311: While unplugging a hotplate with beaker placed on top, student's hand slipped and beaker broke, resulting in cut to hand. Supervisor reinstructed student to ensure glassware is always removed prior to shutting down equipment.
- 3. JHE-207: While unclamping threaded bar from bandsaw, bar fell and student caught bar, cutting two fingers. Supervisor instructed student to ask for assistance when working on bandsaw with large or awkward items.
