Chemical Engineering – ABB 360 First Aid Eye Irritation	
Incident Description:	
-While dispensing dilute solution of fluorescein isothiocyanate labelled microgels into a petri dish by syringe, the liquid sprayed back onto student's face and clothes. Although wearing safety glasses, solution dripped into left eye.	

Resolution:

- Student rinsed eye.
- -Air bubbles in syringe contributed to uneven dispensing pressure and dispense into corner of dish where less likely to splash.

Engineering - GHC

First Aid Abrasion/Contusion

Incident Description:

-While repositioning jack stand under Baja car the student's finger was in a pinch point and they bumped the locking lever, dropping the centre column and pinching their finger.

Resolution:

- Reposition jack stands using legs and feet instead of ratchet mechanism/locking handle.

Civil Engineering – JHE 220

Hazard

Incident Description:

-Fire alarm triggered when furnace began smoking when attempting to make charcoal from large amount of wood. Small batch had worked fine.

Resolution:

-Study of proper use of furnace to be done as well as specifications of exhaust hood

Engineering Physics – TAB 205

Hazard

Incident Description:

- Temperature of lab exceeded 35C more than once causing damage to refrigeration units and putting instruments and people at risk.

Incident, No FA – ABB C317

Incident Description:

-EE fainted while working at lab bench.

Resolution:

- Communication to ensure EE well enough to return and to encourage breaks.
- -Recommend working with a fume hood.
