| Resolution: Communication to the responsible person (shuttle services) undertaken and EE reminded to watch for hazards on the bus.  |  |
| CEDT – TAB 110 and 205<br>No Injury – Hazard  |  |

Following upgrade to air handling system in TAB, water was noticed in compressed air lines in TAB 110/A and TAB 205. Pneumatic valves on equipment affected potentially causing a hazard to operators and to the equipment.

#### Resolution:

Further modifications will be made to air system to eliminate water and improve pressure to the building.

Mechanical Engineering—JHE-A202/A No Injury – Hazard

#### Incident:

PhD student was performing hydrothermal experiment of wood residue, water and citric acid heated to 280C in pressure valve. Approximately halfway into reaction the disk burst and released contents, spraying wall and ceiling.

#### Resolution:

An investigation as to why the disk ruptured was undertaken – at this time it is still not know. Could be the disk was fatigued from previous experiments or vessel over pressurized for some reason. However, this was not the first time the experiment ran.
