Civil Engineering – ADL First Aid: Fracture – finger	
<i>Incident:</i> Student tripped on a cylinder on the floor when she moved from her station to continue with further testing of the cylinder. Cylinder fell on her hand and caused a cut and fracture of a finger.	
Resolution:	

Re-instruction and improve work procedure. Review placement of cylinders pre- testing. Remind students to be aware of surrounding.	
B. Tech Engineering – ETB-312 Hazard – No Injury	
<i>Incident:</i> 20L of 3M HCI prepared for lab preparation was placed on cart and later moved. The spigot of the container opened slightly causing a slow leak.	
<i>Resolution:</i> Improve work procedures, direct staff to not store hazardous chemicals on cart. Replace the spigot with a model that will not open easily. Review spill response.	
Mechanical Engineering – ETB-306A Hazard – No Injury	
<i>Incident:</i> BSL-1 liquid waste to be tested with bleach and allowed to sit for 30 minutes be- fore disposal, the SOP was not followed, and the waste was disposed of after 10- 15 minutes.	
Resolution: Reinstruction of person involved.	
Mechanical Engineering – ABB Tower – C317 Healthcare: Cut/Laceration – Hand	
<i>Incident:</i> While working at the benchtop, person experienced pain due to cuts from tiny shards of glass.	
<i>Resolution:</i> Dedicate space on bench for substrate preparation, revise sharps SOP to include section on glass and substrate preparation, re-train, and replace current cutting tools.
