In 2015 – 3 long duration lost time claims make up 60% of the total lost time days In 2016 – 2 long duration lost time claims make up 74% of the total lost time days In 2017 – 2 long duration lost time claims make up 76% of the total lost time days




The number of lost time WSIB claims increased by 3 from 2016 to 2017. Of the 19 lost time claims, 11 or 58% incurred 5 days or less of lost time, while 8 or 42% of claims account for greater than 5 days of lost time.




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Incidents Resulting in WSIB Claims 2017
