

Summary: Ethical principles

- be honest

- disclose conflict of interest in advance
(potential, perceivable/perceived.
real or not (yet))

- loyalty to employer/client, fulfill obligations, contract,
confidentiality, (restraint on going public)

- decision making: eng. prof. opinion, advice, consequences of
not following eng. recommendations, but often not eng. decision

- public welfare, safety (environment) (priority)

- don't accept payment for services you do not believe you can deliver, incl. not being able to fulfill the intended purpose
- look out for own interests (individual, profession as a whole)
- obey law
- learn, keep up to date,
- know own limitations, don't accept assignments beyond own ability

- share own knowledge.
- contribute to profession
- acknowledge contribution of colleagues
- avoid unfair competition
(loyal to other engineers)
